



## SPECIFICATION for Banjo Cloth

**Banjo** is a woven fabric. Woven, dyed & finished at an I.S.O 9000 rated plant. The fabric is woven with Inherently Fire-Resistant fiber (yarns) creating a fabric which in unaltered form will remain fire resistant for the life of the product. The finished fabric is 47/48" wide with a construction of 95 x 28 per square inch. The warp yarn is a 1ply 150 denier Bright Flat Polyester and the filling is a 6 singles 100% Polyester. It weighs 6 ounces per square yard or 8 ounces per linear yard.

The fire-resistant tests that it passes are:

- National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) 701-2014, test method #1.
- California State Fire Marshall Registration No. F-232.02
- British BS 5867: Part 2.1980
- ASTM E-84 Class 1 or A. (a.k.a. NFPA 255 )

This fabric contains no Fiber Glass or Asbestos.
